Young people can register on oxme.info to tell us what course or training they are doing - or if they are not in employment, education, or training, they can register to get extra support. They can also sign up for our regular Hot Jobs email, all about the best opportunities for young people in Oxfordshire.

Oxme.info also has lots of information – about health for young people, staying safe, help with bullying, finding activities, e-safety and more. If young people have questions or are seeking more information, a member of the oxme team is available to chat live 10am – 5pm Mon-Thu and 10am-4pm Fri. Outside hours you can leave a message and the team will reply the next working day.
