Jobs

Filter jobs by entry requirements using a traffic light system:

Green = no formal qualifications required;
Amber = some qualifications may be required dependent upon employer and individual vacancy and;
Red = formal qualifications are required.

Sectors and pathways

Easily digestible information relating to accessible career pathways, skills needed for those jobs, employment sectors and salaries.

Information Hub

Understand the progression routes in the county and what you need to do to gain employment.
