What is Access to Work?

- Special Equipment or adaptations
- A support worker or job coach to help in the work place
- Disability awareness training for colleagues
- Communication support at a job interview or in the workplace
- The cost of moving equipment following a change in location/job
- Travel to work support for those who cannot use public transport or drive
- An Access to Work Mental Health Support service for people who are absent from work or experience difficulties with their wellbeing
