# Careers in Health and Social Care – helping you to learn new skills

**A Supported Internship in Health and Social care is a college course/ work placement where you will learn skills to help you get a job.**

- **What is a Supported Internship in Health and Social Care?**  
You'll learn the skills you need in a way that works for you. Your Health and Social Care work placement will be friendly and give you hands-on experience. You will learn all you need with your employer's help and in-work support from our employment advisors.

## **How long does the Supported Internship last?**

The Supported internship starts in September and ends by July. You will spend 3 days a week at your work placement which will be in a Health and Social Care setting.



1 day learning in the classroom at Activate college and 1 day off. When it ends, your successful Supported Internship period with your employer having gone well, Oxfordshire Employment and your new employer will support you into a paid job.



## Who can apply?

To apply for a supported internship, you need to:

1. Have a disability or long-term health condition.
2. Be 16-24 years old.
3. Have, or applied for, an Education Health Care Plan (EHCP).
