

Hot Topic Boardgame: Staying safe online & AI

How to Play

You will need:

- Dice
- One token per player (coin, counter or small object)
- Pen and paper to record comments



How it works:

- Place tokens on START.
- Take turns rolling the dice and moving spaces (you can pass if you do not want to answer a question)
- Answer the question on your square.
- Follow any movement or activity instructions.
- Encourage everyone to join in respectfully.
- First to reach FINISH wins!
