3. This prize draw is open to young people aged 16-19 (up to 25 if there are learning difficulties or disabilities) who live in Oxfordshire.
4. By entering this prize draw, entrants agree to be bound by these terms and conditions.
5. You can only enter this prize draw once.
6. To qualify, you must enter all the information required on the form.
7. Entries that are incomplete, altered or not submitted in good faith may be disqualified.
8. No responsibility is taken for lost or delayed entries, for any reason.
9. The prize is £15 in shopping vouchers. There is no cash alternative to the prize.
10. The winner will be picked at random from all eligible entries received.
11. The winner will be notified that they have won the prize draw by post to the address provided. If the address provided is incorrect or partial, we will try our best to reach you, but if you cannot be contacted in a reasonable period or you refuse the prize, another winner will be picked and given the prize after a second draw.
